The essay must be:

- 500 words in length
- Neatly typewritten
- Double-spaced
- Arial or Times New Roman font
- Well-edited to conform to conventions of standard English
- Printed on the front side of 8 ½ X 11 white paper
- Composed by the applicant
- Signed by the applicant
